THANK YOU

June 3, 2024 marks the sixth anniversary of my joining First Presbyterian Church as your CRE Lay Pastor. The time has just flown by!!

I would like to take this opportunity to thank each and everyone of you for making the last 6 years so special. They have been some of the best years of my life. I have greatly appreciated the care and support you have given me as we navigated some "interesting" times during those years. We have enjoyed many "highlights" and only a couple of "other-lights."

By far and away, our biggest hurdle came as a result of the CVID pandemic. We pulled together and found ways, within the government guidelines to re-open as fast as possible. We were one of the first local churches to return to in-person worship. We were smart and practical in how we approached our return. Do you realize we lost no one to the pandemic. Yes, a few of us came down with COVID, but we handled it with reasonable precautions.

I can emphatically state COVID is OVER. The pandemic has disappeared, like the setting of the sun, and has no real impact left. As a result, the Session is establishing some new ideas for Outreach into our community and some of the ministries we support. We are currently working with "Meals-on-Wheels" and "The Bemidji Food Shelf" as well as financially supporting several ministries.

Many things have returned to "normal" including weekly Coffee Fellowship and quarterly "Table Fellowship" meaning a quarterly pot luck meal following services. In addition, the Hand Bell Choir has returned under the leadership of Darlinda Coe.

If you have been absent for some time, there are plenty of opportunities to plug back into the life of the church. If you feel so inclined, please contact me directly and together we can find what your interests are and where you might be interested in "plugin in." One of the first tasks in Outreach was to let the public know we are still active. Our new marque has added much to the process of informing the public. We had some growing pains with the new system and we are nearly complete with this tremendous endeavor. It really looks terrific and provides us a quick means to advertise upcoming events.

On the immediate horizon are three projects: First, we will be having an open house that coincides with the Bemidji Dragon Boat races. Saturday is the big race day and people park and walk past our church. We will offer free cold water, possibly fruit or some other food from about 10:30 until 2:30. We will invite people to come inside and see what the first church in Bemidji looks like. Darlinda will play the organ if so requested. We will also hand out a brochure telling the story of our church.

Next, for the first time in a very long time, we will be an active participant in the Bemidji Area Church Musicians Summer Concerts. In the past we have offered our church as a venue. This time our own organist, Darlinda Coe, will be performing for the concert followed by a meal in the Fellowship Hall. We anticipate 80 people staying for lunch.

Again, during Advent, we will host the community wide Christmas Carol Sing-along. Once we are anticipating Darlinda and Wayne Hoff playing duets on the piano and organ. We had a tremendous turnout for this "First Annual Christmas Carol Sing-a-long." We received positive feedback for many weeks following the event. Based on the excitement from last year's event, we anticipate well over 100 folks to attend.

None of this would be possible if without your tremendous support and enthusiasm. Your enthusiasm is what keeps me going and it is this enthusiasm that makes me appreciate all of you even more. If you have been gone for some time, please consider returning and becoming part of this enthusiastic group.

Thanks again for six of the most incredible years of my life.


